Long-Range Transportation Plan (LRTP) Listening Sessions: The Long-Range Transportation Plan (LRTP) will be updated in 2019 and seeks to add regionally significant planning projects to the plan. WestCOG is continuing to coordinate listening sessions within each municipality to discuss the LRTP.

## **ACTION ITEMS**

SWRMPO Approval of 10/18/2018 Meeting Minutes: CEO Kimberlee Morton of Norwalk Transit District (NTD) noted that NTD was in fact present at the last meeting and corrected a misspelling in the minutes of 10/28/2018. SWRMPO Performance Measures and Target Setting: Based on the requirements of the final rule, CTDOT has set targets for several performance measures. On a motion made by Chief of Staff Michael Pollard and seconded by First Selectman Chris Spaulding, the SWRMPO endorsed the resolution supporting the targets established by CTDOT.
