INFORMATIONAL ITEMS

Statewide Transportation Improvement Meeting: WestCOG Senior Planner Kristin Hadjstylianos gave an update on the STIP. CTDOT distributed a draft list of projects for each MPO to be used in the Air Quality Conformity Analysis modeling. Staff are asking the municipalities to review the list and submit comments to WestCOG staff by July 24^{th.}

Pavement Meeting Update and Survey: WestCOG Senior Project Manager Kevin Mahoney gave an update on the meeting held on June 26th regarding below-expectation performance of asphalt pavement in the region. As a result of the meeting, a state-wide survey will be conducted to see if other municipalities are having the same issues. Additionally, the CAP Lab is willing to collect and evaluate a limited number of cores from under-

performing pavement areas in the region. The draft solicitation for cores sites was reviewed and it was decided to establish an August 15 response date.
