CALL TO ORDER/ PUBLIC COMMENT

The meeting was called to order at 11:01am by Senior Planner Kristin Hadjstylianos. There were no public comments made.

FEATURED PRESENTATION

James Mahoney, Associate Program Director for CT Transportation Lab and Executive Program Director for CT Advanced Pavement Lab presented an asphalt pavement deterioration review. Mr. Mahoney shared photos and results of the asphalt samples taken in our region. Going forward he recommends municipalities should ensure proper preparation and proper compaction on edges for full depth reclamations to get the maximum life out of

asphalt and recommends that municipalities should measure density at time of construction to insure it meets CTDOT specifications.

INFORMATIONAL ITEMS

FTA Section 5310 Grant Program: WestCOG Senior Planner Todd Fontanella gave an update on the grant solicitation availability to improve mobility for seniors and individuals with disabilities. Eligible recipients include private non-profit organizations, state or local government authorities and operators of public transportation. If you would like WestCOG to review your application for completeness, please submit your draft application to WestCOG staff by June 19th. Final applications are due to WestCOG and CTDOT by June 26th.

State Matching Grant Program (MGP) for Elderly and Demand Response Transportation: WestCOG Senior Planner Todd Fontanella gave an update on the 2021 application process for the MGP, which provides matching funds for transportation services for seniors and persons with disabilities to each municipality. Applications are due to WestCOG and CTDOT by June 1st.

Approval of 4/8/2020 Minutes: After review and on a motion made by Newtown Director of Public Works Fred Hurley and seconded by Stamford Transportation Bureau Chief Jim Travers, the minutes of the April 8th meeting were unanimously approved.

2018–2021 Transportation Improvement Program: After a review by WestCOG Assistant Planner Nicole Sullivan and on a motion made by Weston Director of Land Use Tracey Kulikowski and seconded by Newtown Director of Public Works Fred Hurley, the SWRMPO TIP Amendment#2020-0521: Replace Traffic Control Signals at Various Locations was unanimously approved as presented in the memo.

Discussion Items as Raised by the TAG: WestCOG Assistant Planner Nicole Sullivan gave an update on the Hazard Mitigation Plan.
