CALL TO ORDER/ PUBLIC COMMENT

The meeting was called to order at 11:01am by Principal Planner Kristin Hadjstylianos. There were no public comments made.

INFORMATIONAL ITEMS

Sustainable CT Intern Fellows 2020: WestCOG Deputy Director Mike Towle gave an update on the sustainable CT program and introduced our fellows, Chad Schroeder and Hamsa Ganapati. The program is intended to recognize communities' sustainability actions and achievements. Currently, thirteen of our member municipalities are working on this program.

Regional Stormwater Mapping – Meet Tucker Beckett: WestCOG Deputy Director Mike Towle introduced our newest employee, Tucker Beckett. He will be the project lead on the WestCOG MS4 stormwater mapping project. WestCOG's objective is to provide mapping services to close the gaps between towns and the MS4 permit requirements. CTDOT Title VI Program, Proposed Service and Fare Equity Policies – Public Comment Period: WestCOG Principal Planner Kristin Hadjstylianos asked TAG members to provide feedback on CTDOT's Proposed Services and Fare Equity Policies as they complete their Title VI Program update. Comments will be accepted from July 1 through August 14th via email.

ACTION ITEMS

Approval of 6/9/2020 Minutes: After review and on a motion made by Greenwich Deputy Commissioner of Public Works James Michel and seconded by Brookfield Project Manager Greg Dembowski, the minutes of the June 9th meeting were unanimously approved.

LOTCIP Proposals: WestCOG Senior Project Manager Kevin Mahoney provided a summary of the proposals and staff review results and analysis from the most recent LOTCIP solicitation. Of the thirteen project proposals submitted, ten are recommended for COG endorsement at this time. The LOTCIP funds associated with these ten projects is approximately \$17.8 million. The preliminary determinations of LOTCIP eligibility were made by WestCOG staff. The eligibility of some projects will depend on detailed information regarding existing infrastructure condition and proposed remedial work. Final eligibility determinations will be made by CT DOT upon submission of an Application and supporting information. After review and on a motion made by Brookfield Project Manager Greg Dembowski and seconded by Stamford Transportation Bureau Chief Jim Travers, the TAG unanimously concurred with the WestCOG staff recommendations.
