## **INFORMATION ITEMS**

**FHWA Highway Safety Performance Targets for 2021:** WestCOG Associate Planner Nicole Sullivan gave an update on CTDOT's proposed safety targets for 2021. CTDOT has proposed returning to the 2014/2015 safety target levels. The next step is for MPO members to consider endorsing the CTDOT safety targets as presented or to develop different safety targets before the 180-day window closes on February 26, 2021.

**Congestion Mitigation Air Quality (CMAQ) Program:** WestCOG Principal Planner Kristin Hadjstylianos gave an update on the Congestion Mitigation and Air Quality Program (CMAQ), which is a federal program that provides funds to transportation projects and programs that contribute to maintenance of air quality standards. Based on the preliminary schedule, complete applications will be due to WestCOG by February 21, 2021. MPO members expressed an interest in completing a region-wide application for electric vehicles and charging stations.

## **ACTION ITEMS**

**SWRMPO Approval of 11/19/2020 Meeting Minutes:** After review and on a motion made by Westport First Selectman James Marpe and seconded by Wilton First Selectman Lynne Vanderslice, the minutes of the 11/19/2020 meeting were unanimously approved.

## **OTHER BUSINESS**

WestCOG Senior Planner Todd Fontanella gave an update on the 5310 Grant Applications, which supported programs to improved mobility for seniors and individuals with disabilities. On December 15<sup>th</sup> WestCOG was notified by email that the WHEELS of New Milford, Ability Beyond Disability, and ARI of Connecticut Section 5310 Traditional Project applications (accessible vehicles) were awarded.
