WestCOG, in collaboration with the City of Danbury and Town of New Fairfield, is developing the Danbury and New Fairfield Corridor Study for Route 37 between I-84 Exit 6 in Danbury to 0.2 miles north of Route 39 in New Fairfield. The study aims to find solutions to alleviate traffic congestion, improve pedestrian mobility, and to promote healthy and environmentally friendly modes of transportation.
