LOTCIP Project Solicitation: WestCOG Senior Project Manager Kevin Mahoney indicated WestCOG intends to solicit projects for LOTCIP fundings. The LOTCIP Solicitation has been drafted and will involve the following requirements:

- 1. The COG needs to authorize the Solicitation.
- 2. The DOT is expected to update to the LOTCIP guidelines before the Solicitation is released. Municipalities should be putting together anticipated projects as once the Solicitation is released, there will a

Study for Conceptual Development of Congestion Reduction Project: WestCOG Senior Project Manager Kevin Mahoney indicated an intent to issue a RFQ for a consultant to study congestion hotspots across the region. The intent is to create a pipeline of municipally-administered, congestion reduction projects, the study will exclude consideration of mainline freeways (e.g., Route 15, I-84, I-95).
