# Transportation

Safe Streets and Roads for All Grant - USDOT awarded WestCOG's Implementation Grant.

**RAISE Grant** – WestCOG is working on grant agreement requirements.

Norwalk Route 1 – WestCOG is negotiating with consultants this month.

- Traffic Calming and Complete Streets Best Practices Toolbox WestCOG received approval from CTDOT to move forward with the study and are planning for the solicitation to be released in mid-January.
- Quiet Zone Study Consultant is meeting with municipalities and preparing for upcoming public engagement.
- ADA Transition Plans CTDOT is planning to provide resources and assistance to municipalities for the development of plans.
- **Transportation Improvement Program FY25-28** CTDOT is performing air quality modeling on projects, expect the results to be finalized in February at which time the Draft FY25-28 TIP will be released for public comment.

# Regional Planning/Services Project Updates

Farm Viability Grant – WestCOG expects to execute a contract with a consultant this month.

**SAID Project** - WestCOG is waiting on data available from the state's flyover.

**Drone Program** – There was a discussion of WestCOG's program and the different uses for the drone.

**Public Safety Training Facility** – There was a discussion on the public safety training facility and work to narrow down the proposed location of the facility.

Affordable Housing Financing Study – Consultants are preparing a draft of the report and tool.

Climate Pollution Reduction Grant – The Priority Climate Action Plan is under development with a consultant and is expected to be completed in March. WestCOG will work with municipalities on future grant opportunities.
